TREATY FIRST NATION DEFINITION REGULATION

B.C. Reg. 179/2024

Definitions

1 In this regulation:

“**Act**” means the *Offence Act*;

“**Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ**” means the Ucluelet First Nation as defined in section 29.1.1 of the Maa-nulth First Nations Final Agreement.

Treaty first nation

2 The following are prescribed for the purposes of the definition of “treaty first nation” in section 1 of the Act:

- (a) Tsawwassen First Nation;
- (b) Huu-ay-aht First Nations;
- (c) Ka:’yu:’k’t’h’ /Che:k’les7et’h’ First Nations;
- (d) Toquaht Nation;
- (e) Uchucklesaht Tribe;
- (f) Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ;
- (g) Tla’amin Nation.
