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Interpretation

- 1 In this regulation:

“**Act**” means the *Medical Research (BC Cancer Agency) and Health Status Registry Act*;

“**information**” means information or classes of information relevant to medical research into the prevention, causes, diagnosis, treatment and outcomes of cancer or its precursor lesions and includes records containing that information.

- 3 Health identifiers
 - (a) health insurance number;
 - (b) personal health number.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

- 1 Records from medical laboratories, imaging services, hospitals and other health facilities and physicians.
- 2 Mortality and morbidity data including autopsy reports.

FACTORS WHICH INFLUENCE THE OCCURRENCE OF CANCER IN HUMAN POPULATIONS

- 1 Intrinsic host factors
 - (a) ethnicity;
 - (b) medical history.
