



## CHAPTER 2.

### An Act to amend the "Administration Act."

R.S.B.C. 1936, c. 5;  
1939, c. 2; 1941-42,  
c. 2; 1946, c. 2.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1947.]

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Administration Act Amendment Act, 1947." Short title.

2. Section 35 of the "Administration Act," being chapter 5 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936," is amended by striking out the first six lines thereof, and substituting the following:— Amends s. 35.

"35. Where the accounts of the petitioning personal representative have been passed pursuant to section 91 of the 'Trustee Act,' and the Court is satisfied that no further passing of accounts is necessary, or where all parties agree, then upon a person or trust company being."

3. Section 91 is repealed. Repeals s. 91.
