



CHAPTER 1.

An Act to amend the "Interpretation Act."

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Interpretation Act Amendment Act, 1947." Short title.

2. Section 23 of the "Interpretation Act," being chapter 1 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936," is amended Amends s. 23. by striking out subsection (17), which was added to that section by chapter 1 of the Statutes of 1943, and substituting the following:—

"(17.) Where the expression 'the continuance of the war' or 'the conclusion of the war' or any expression of like import is used in any Statute passed after the thirty-first day of October, 1939, and before the twelfth day of April, 1946, the conclusion of the war shall for the purposes of such Act be deemed to take place at midnight on the thirtieth day of June, 1947."
