



CHAPTER 52.

An Act to amend the "Legal Professions Act."

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Legal Professions Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1947."

2. Section 32 of the "Legal Professions Act," being chapter 149 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936," is amended by striking out the words "in the month of July or August as may be determined by the Benchers" in the fourth and fifth lines, and substituting "as the Benchers in their discretion may determine."

3. Section 39 of the "Legal Professions Act," being chapter 149 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936," is amended by adding the following as subsection (10) :—

"(10.) They may in their discretion provide, out of the funds of the Society, for a pension allowance to any employee of the Society and his dependents on the retirement or resignation of such employee."
