



CHAPTER 81.

An Act to authorize the Flooding of certain
Lands in the Skagit River Valley.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1947.]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia,
enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Skagit Valley Lands Act." Short title.
2. The City of Seattle is authorized to cause Lot 1103, Yale District, to be flooded, under such conditions and restrictions as may be decided by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council; and such land, when flooded, shall be deemed to be improved land, and as such shall be subject to taxation under the provisions of the "Taxation Act." Authority to flood Lot 1103, Yale District.
3. The provisions of section 2 shall not come into effect until The City of Seattle has paid to the Province such sum of money, as compensation for damages, as may be agreed upon between the City and the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, which sum may include an amount of money agreed upon in lieu of rentals or other current charges. Commencement of Act.
