



CHAPTER 23.

An Act to amend the "Curators Act."

R.S.B.C. 1936, c. 69.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1947.]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Curators Act Amendment Act, 1947." Short title.
2. Section 4 of the "Curators Act," being chapter 69 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936," is amended by striking out the figures "80, 81, 88, and 90" in the third line of subsection (2), and substituting "80, 81, 82A, 88, 90, 91, and 92." Amends s. 4.
3. Section 8 is amended by striking out "by the Judge or by such officer or referee as the Judge may appoint for that purpose" in the tenth and eleventh lines of subsection (1), and substituting "in accordance with the provisions for passing the accounts of trustees under the 'Trustee Act' and rules thereunder." Amends s. 8.
4. Section 10 is amended by striking out "by the Judge, or by such officer or referee as the Judge may appoint for that purpose" in the fifth and sixth lines, and substituting "in accordance with the provisions for passing the accounts of trustees under the 'Trustee Act' and rules thereunder." Amends s. 10.
