



CHAPTER 27.

An Act to amend the "Municipal Elections Act."

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Municipal Elections Act Amendment Act, 1947." Short title.
2. Section 7 of the "Municipal Elections Act," being chapter 83 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936," is amended by striking out the words "of the assessed value of not less than one hundred dollars" in the third and fourth lines of clause (a) of subsection (1). Amends s. 7.
3. Section 12 is amended by striking out the words "of the assessed value of not less than one hundred dollars" in the third and fourth lines of clause (a) of subsection (1). Amends s. 12.
4. Section 14 is repealed. Repeals s. 14.
5. Section 24 is amended by striking out the words "irrespective of wards" at the end of clause (c) of subsection (1). Amends s. 24.
6. Section 25 is amended by striking out the words "wards or" in the last line. Amends s. 25.
7. Section 43 is amended by striking out clause (b). Amends s. 43.
8. Said section 43 is further amended by striking out the words "a municipality is not divided into wards, and" in the first line of clause (c). Further amends s. 43.
