



## CHAPTER 18.

An Act respecting the Purchase of Goods within the Province under Charge Accounts and Contracts of Sale.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1947.]

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Consumer Credit Act." Short title.
2. (1.) The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may make regulations respecting the sale and purchase of goods on credit or on the deferred-payment plan. Power to make regulations.  
 (2.) The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may also make regulations providing for the enforcement of regulations made under this section, and providing for penalties for violation of these regulations.  
 (3.) No regulation shall be made under this Act after the date on which the first session of the Legislature in 1948 ends, and every regulation theretofore made under this Act shall cease to be operative on that date.
