



CHAPTER 11.

An Act authorizing the Making of Agreements with the Government of Canada respecting Land-development, Public Works, Flood-control, Hospitals, Schools, and other Matters.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1947.]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Canada-British Columbia Joint Development Act." Short title

2. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may from time to time authorize any Minister of the Province to enter into and carry out any agreement with any Minister or authority of the Government of Canada, or jointly with the said Minister or authority and any improvement district, respecting water and land development, highway construction or improvement, flood-control, hospitals, schools, and other matters in the Province, and to implement such agreement. Power to authorize agreements

3. In any such agreement made pursuant to section 2, the Minister authorized pursuant to that section may undertake on behalf of British Columbia to acquire rights-of-way for any works, to make surveys, reports, and estimates of cost of any project, to build structures, and to carry out any project, and to maintain and operate any works to which the agreement relates. Power to give undertakings

4. In the absence of a special vote of the Legislature for the purpose, the expenses incurred in carrying out the terms of any Expenses incurred
