



## CHAPTER 46.

## An Act to amend the "Jury Act."

R.S.B.C. 1936, c. 136;

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Jury Act Amendment Act, Short title. 1947."

2. The amendments enacted by sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 of the "Jury Act Amendment Act, 1945," which amendments were to come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council by his Proclamation, and in respect of which no Proclamation has been made, are repealed. Repeals ss 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 of 1945 Act.

3. Section 7 of the "Jury Act," being chapter 136 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936," is amended by inserting after "surgeons," in the first line of clause (k), the words "registered Christian Science practitioners." Amends s. 7.

4. Section 44 is amended by striking out "Upon cause shown to his satisfaction, the presiding Judge" in the first line, and substituting "At any time or times before the sittings of any Court of Oyer and Terminer and General Gaol Delivery any Judge or local Judge of the Supreme Court, and at any time or times during the sittings the presiding Judge, upon cause shown."
