



## CHAPTER 77.

An Act to amend the "Richmond Drainage  
and Dyking Act, 1936."1936, c. 53; 1937,  
c. 66.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1947.]

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia,  
enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Richmond Drainage and Dyking Act, 1936, Amendment Act, 1947." Short title.

2. Section 2 of the "Richmond Drainage and Dyking Act, 1936," being chapter 53 of the Statutes of 1936, is amended by striking out "one dollar, and on any separate parcel of land on which there are no improvements as shown by said roll shall be twenty-five cents" in the nineteenth, twentieth, and twenty-first lines of clause (g) of subsection (1), and substituting the words "such amount, not being less than one dollar and not more than three dollars, as the Council fixes by such by-law or by-laws, and on any separate parcel of land on which there are no improvements as shown by said roll shall be such amount, not being less than twenty-five cents and not more than one dollar, as the Council fixes by such by-law or by-laws." Amends s. 2.
