



## CHAPTER 92.

An Act to amend the "Tuberculosis  
Institutions Act."R.S.B.C. 1936, c. 293:  
1939, c. 58.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1947.]

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia,  
enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Tuberculosis Institutions Short title.  
Act Amendment Act, 1947."

2. Section 6 of the "Tuberculosis Institutions Act," being Amends s. 6.  
chapter 293 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936,"  
is amended by striking out subsection (1), and substituting the  
following:—

"(1.) The municipality in which a person admitted to a Pro-  
vincial Tuberculosis Institution as a patient is resident shall pay  
to the Minister of Finance for the maintenance of that patient  
during the time that he is a patient, including the day of admis-  
sion but not the day of discharge, a sum that is equal to twenty  
per centum of the average per diem cost of the support and main-  
tenance of a patient of the Provincial Tuberculosis Institutions  
for the fiscal year ended on the previous thirty-first day of  
March."
