MINISTER'S ORDER FOR A VOTE ON  
INCORPORATION OF SALTSRING ISLAND

It is hereby directed pursuant to sections 8(2) and 11.1 of the *Local Government Act*, that a vote be taken to ascertain whether or not the electors of Saltspring Island, of the Capital Regional District, are in favour of incorporating as an Island Municipality.

For the purpose of the vote the boundary includes all of Saltspring Island except Fulford Harbour Indian Reserve No. 5, plus all of the islands within Ganges Harbour and Russell and Idol Islands.

The Minister hereby Orders as follows:

The vote shall be taken on Saturday, June 22, 2002.

The Chief Election Officer for the vote shall be Tom Moore. The Chief Election Officer shall appoint a deputy chief election officer and election officials as required for the administration and conduct of the vote.

Insofar as it is not inconsistent with the provisions of this directive, Parts 3 and 4 of the *Local Government Act* and the "Capital Regional District Elections Bylaw No. 2162, 1993" shall apply with necessary changes as are applicable to the conduct of this vote.

Advance voting opportunities shall be held in accordance with "CRD Elections Bylaw No. 2162, 1993" and Section 163(1) of the *Local Government Act*.

The question on the ballot shall be:

"Are you in favour of the incorporation of a Saltspring Island Municipality"
