Application having been made by **INTERNATIONAL RAIL ROAD SYSTEMS INC.**, (IRRS) on behalf of the **MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION** for approval of a new highway crossing at (IRRS) Mile 149.35, Fruitvale Arterial # 202R (Highway 3B), at Fruitvale, British Columbia, as shown in documentation filed with the Ministry of Community, Aboriginal & Women's Services in support of this application, and the Chief Inspecting Engineer having signified consent:

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of section 144(2) of the "Railway Act", this application is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. The crossing shall be constructed and thereafter maintained in accordance to the Part 3 of the Railway Safety Code.
2. Whistle boards and flanger signs are to be displayed to rail traffic.
3. Automatic crossing signals and railway crossing signs are to be displayed to vehicular traffic.
4. The costs of construction, inspection and maintenance of the crossing, are the responsibility of the Ministry of Transportation, and
5. The cost of inspection and maintenance of the automatic crossing warning signals is to be shared 50% by International Rail Road Systems Inc. and 50% by the Ministry of Transportation.
