MINISTER'S ORDER
VOTE ON THE INCORPORATION OF LANTZVILLE

It is hereby directed pursuant to sections 8(2) of the *Local Government Act*, that a vote be taken to ascertain whether or not the electors of the community of Lantzville, within the Regional District of Nanaimo, are in favour of incorporating as a Municipality.

For the purpose of the vote the boundary of the proposed municipality shall include that part of electoral area D of the Regional District of Nanaimo shown on the map attached to and forming part of this Order, following the boundary of the Lantzville Improvement District except where otherwise shown.

The Minister hereby Orders as follows:

1. The vote shall be taken on Saturday, November 16, 2002.
2. The Chief Election Officer for the vote shall be Carol Mason, the Chief Election Officer of the Regional District of Nanaimo. The Chief Election Officer shall appoint a deputy chief election officer and election officials as required for the administration and conduct of the vote.
3. Insofar as it is not inconsistent with the provisions of this directive, Parts 3 and 4 of the *Local Government Act* and the "Regional District of Nanaimo General Local Election Bylaw No. 1292, 2002" shall apply with necessary changes as are applicable to the conduct of this vote.
4. The question on the ballot shall be:


"Are you in favour of the incorporation of Lantzville as a municipality?"
