Ministerial Order No.

M 334

I, Rich Coleman, Solicitor General, order that Cathay Gibson:

- a) be reappointed as a Vice-Chair of the Manufactured Home Park Dispute Resolution Committee for a term to expire March 31, 2003,
- b) the remuneration for Cathay Gibson shall be the maximum amount per diem rate payable under Treasury Board Directive 1/00 for a Vice-Chair of regulatory agencies, boards and commissions. Per Diem payments shall be calculated in the following manner for each 24 hour day:
 - for less than eight hours of work, the appointee will be entitled to an hourly rate of \$37.50 per hour; and
 - for eight or more hours of work, the appointee will be entitled to a full per diem; and
- c) be reimbursed at the Group II rate for reasonable and out-of-pocket expenses necessarily incurred while carrying out the duties as a Vice-Chair of the Manufactured Home Park Dispute Resolution Committee.
