Ministerial Order No. M363

- (c) the Power Engineers, Boiler, Pressure Vessel and Refrigeration Safety Regulation, B.C. Reg. 104/2004, is amended as set out in Schedule 3.

## SCHEDULE 1

- 1 Section 2 of the Electrical Safety Regulation, B.C. Reg. 100/2004, is amended**
  - (a) by repealing the definition of “industry training credential”, and**
  - (b) by adding the following definition:**

“SkilledTradesBC certificate” has the same meaning as “certificate of qualification” in the *Skilled Trades BC Act*; .
- 2 Section 4 is amended**
  - (a) in subsections (1) (a) and (2) (c) by striking out “industry training credential” in both places and substituting “SkilledTradesBC certificate”, and**
  - (b) in subsection (3) by striking out “or section 12 of this regulation”.**
- 3 Section 8 (1) (a) is amended by striking out “industry training credential” and substituting “SkilledTradesBC certificate”.**
- 4 Section 12 is repealed.**

## SCHEDULE 2

- 1 Section 2 of the Gas Safety Regulation, B.C. Reg. 103/2004, is amended**
  - (a) by repealing the definitions of “industry training credential” and “trainee”, and**
  - (b) by adding the following definitions:**

“**apprentice**” has the same meaning as in the *Skilled Trades BC Act*;

“**SkilledTradesBC certificate**” has the same meaning as “certificate of qualification” in the *Skilled Trades BC Act*; .
- 2 Section 7 (1) is amended**
  - (a) in paragraph (a) (i) by striking out “an industry training credential” and substituting “a SkilledTradesBC certificate”, and**
  - (b) in paragraph (b) by striking out “a trainee” and substituting “an apprentice”.**
- 3 Section 12 (1) (a) is amended by striking out “piping industry training credential” and substituting “SkilledTradesBC certificate”.**
- 4 Section 13 (1) (a) is amended by striking out “certificate of qualification with an interprovincial red seal endorsement” and substituting “SkilledTradesBC certificate or an equivalent recreation vehicle certificate with an interprovincial red seal endorsement”.**
- 5 Sections 14 (1) (a), 15 (1) (a), and 16 (1) (a) are amended by striking out “industry training credential” and substituting “service technician SkilledTradesBC certificate”.**

- 6 *Section 17 (1) (a) is amended by striking out “an industry training credential” and substituting “a SkilledTradesBC certificate”.*

### **SCHEDULE 3**

- 1 *Section 2 of the Power Engineers, Boiler, Pressure Vessel and Refrigeration Safety Regulation, B.C. Reg. 104/2004, is amended in the definition of “refrigeration mechanic” by repealing paragraph (a) and substituting the following:*

(a) a certificate of qualification, issued under the *Skilled Trades BC Act*, as a refrigeration and air conditioning mechanic; .

- 2 *Section 41 is amended*

(a) *in subsection (1) by repealing the definition of “ITA”,*

(b) *in subsection (1) by adding the following definition:*

“**SkilledTradesBC**” means the corporation continued under section 2 (1) of the *Skilled Trades BC Act*; , **and**

(c) *in subsections (3) (a) and (b) and (4) (a) by striking out “the ITA” and substituting “SkilledTradesBC”.*
