ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF

MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS

Local Government Act

Ministerial Order No. M223

WHEREAS pursuant to section 167 of the Local Government Act (the “Act”), if the minister considers that special circumstances exist regarding an election, the minister may make any order the minister considers appropriate to achieve the purposes of Part 4 [Assent Voting] of the Act;

AND WHEREAS on March 11, 2020 the World Health Organization declared the spread of the coronavirus communicable disease (“COVID-19”) to be a pandemic;

AND WHEREAS on March 18, 2020 the Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General declared that a state of emergency exists throughout the whole of the Province of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS on May 18, 2021 statutory approval was given by the Inspector of Municipalities for the “Health Related Services Grant In Aid Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2445, 2021” to proceed to electoral approval;

AND WHEREAS on July 17, 2021 there is to be an assent vote to approve services for the Health Related Services Grant in Aid Service in the Peace River Regional District in accordance with section 170 and section 54 of the Act (“the Peace River Regional District Health Related Services Grant in Aid Service assent vote”);

AND WHEREAS the Peace River Regional District Health Related Services Grant in Aid Service assent vote will take place during the COVID-19 pandemic;

AND WHEREAS the nature of assent votes requires in-person interactions that can increase the transmission risks of COVID-19 and put electors and election officials at increased levels of risk;

AND WHEREAS, I believe that the COVID-19 pandemic constitutes a ‘special circumstance’ for the purposes of s.167 of the Act, and that in order to achieve the purposes of Part 4 [Assent Voting] of the Act, it is appropriate for me to make the following order;

NOW THEREFORE I HEREBY ORDER, pursuant to section 167 of the Act, that:

- 1) As an exception to section 109 (1) of the Act, and despite section 5 of the “Peace River Regional District Elections and Voting Procedures Bylaw 1825, 2008”, or an applicable provision of any other bylaw, the Board may, for the Peace River Regional District Health Related Services Grant in Aid Service assent vote, permit the Peace River Regional District’s Chief Election Officer to establish special voting opportunities or to determine that no special voting opportunities will be held at their sole discretion.
- 2) As an exception to section 110 of the Act, and despite section 6 of the “Peace River Regional District Elections and Voting Procedures Bylaw 1825, 2008”, or an applicable provision of any other bylaw, the Board may, for mail ballot voting in the Peace River Regional District Health Related Services Grant in Aid Service assent vote, by resolution permit:
 - a. voting by all eligible electors under the Act to be done by mail ballot and, in relation to this, may permit elector registration to be done in conjunction with this voting; and
 - b. the Peace River Regional District’s Chief Election Officer to establish procedures for mail ballot voting, including voting, receiving, processing and securing mail ballots at their sole discretion.
- 3) As an exception to section 125 (1) (b) (c) and (2) (a) of the Act, or an applicable provision of any other bylaw, the Board may, for the Peace River Regional District Health Related Services Grant in Aid Service assent vote, by resolution permit the elector, as directed by the election official responsible, to make an oral declaration that the elector is entitled to vote in the assent vote when obtaining a ballot for voting, in which case the election official responsible must make a record that the elector made an oral declaration.
