REGULATION No.20.

For the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of Section 45a. of the "Government Liquor Act", being Chapter 30 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1921, The Liquor Control Board makes the following Regulation to be known as Regulation No. 20 of the Regulations of the Liquor Control Board.

Every advertisement, sign or poster, respecting liquor, published or displayed, shall contain the statement:-
"This advertisement is not published or displayed by the Liquor Control Board or by the Government of British Columbia", in words of a like conspicuous nature as to method of reproduction, color and background as the most conspicuous of the other words contained in the advertisement, sign or poster, and in letters or type not smaller than the largest letter or type appearing in or on the said advertisement, sign or poster.
