The undersigned has the honour to REPORT

THAT the Hon. the Minister of Lands visited Great Britain for the purpose of investigating and inquiring into the subject of Immigration in relation to British Columbia, and other matters, and was absent from the Province in connection therewith from the 15th day of July, 1922 to the 29th day of October, 1922, both inclusive, and while absent on such business incurred expenses for transportation, travelling, hotel, and living expenses amounting to Three Thousand, Seven Hundred and Forty-five Dollars (\$3,745.00):
