The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT Lot 6577, Kootenay District, being the "Sweepstake" Mineral Claim, has reverted to the Crown for non-payment of taxes.

THAT the boundaries of the said Lot are now practically obliterated on the ground and that, therefore it is inconvenient and inadvisable to deal with the said Lot under the "Taxation Act".

THAT the Gold Commissioner at Cranbrook, B.C. reports that no lease has issued, nor is there any application for lease pending under the "Taxation Act".
