To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the Land Settlement Board has been obliged to take over the West half (W. 1/2) of Section Ten (10), Township Seventeen (17), Range Seventeen (17), West of the Sixth Meridian (W. of 6th M.), containing Three Hundred and Twenty (320) acres, more or less, on account of an unsatisfied loan made by the said Board, and has been unable to resell such property at a price sufficient to repay the moneys due in connection with such loan;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT, pursuant to Section 36 of Chapter 34 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1917, being the "Land Settlement and Development Act", the said Board be authorized to reduce the amount of the price of such lands so as to effect a sale;

AND THAT a copy of this Minute of Council, if approved, be forwarded to the Land Settlement Board.
