The undersigned has the honour to REPORT:--

THAT the sum of \$13,545.00 has been received by the Corporation of the District of Saanich under the provisions of Section 108 of the "Government Liquor Act".

AND THAT of this amount the sum of \$6,772.50 is reserved for the purpose of granting aid to Hospitals within the limits of the said Municipality:

AND THAT there are in fact no Hospitals within the said Municipality:

AND THAT a request has been made by the Council that they be permitted to use the said amount of \$6,772.50 as follows:--

1. Thirty-two and one-half per cent of such sum to be paid to the Provincial Royal Jubilee Hospital:
2. Seventeen and one-half per cent of such sum to be paid to the Victorian Order of Nurses for the operation of the Saanich Memorial Health Centre:
3. The balance of fifty per cent of such sum to be paid to the General Revenue account of the Municipality.
