A BY-LAW

to amend the "Waterworks Regulation By-Law, 1918."

IT ENACTED by the Reeve and Council of the Corporation of the District of North Vancouver, in Council assembled, as follows:-

1. - Clause 13 of the "Waterworks Regulation By-Law, 1918," is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted therefor:-

*13. No person shall use water supplied by the Corporation for outside sprinkling nor use a hose for washing windows, verandahs or outside walls of any building in the District, nor sprinkle or use in any manner any water so supplied upon gardens, lawns or grounds of any description, without having first applied for and obtained a permit from the Collector so to do, and paid therefor the sum of two dollars.

Upon receipt of an application accompanied by the said sum of \$2. the Treasurer shall issue to the applicant a permit for the uses aforesaid, and every permit so issued shall expire on the 31st day of December then next ensuing, and the applicant shall during the continuance of the said permit, post the same in a conspicuous place upon the premises in respect of which the same is issued and in such a manner that it may be easily seen from the highway."

2. Clause 35 of said By-Law is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following words, namely:-

"Provided that in the event of the Corporation entirely forbidding the use of water for outside sprinkling as aforesaid, every person affected thereby (being the holder of a permit issued pursuant to Clause 13 hereof) shall be entitled to receive on his next account for water supplied a rebate or allowance for the period during which sprinkling is forbidden, in respect of the amount paid by him for such permit and for the purpose only of determining the amount of such rebate or allowance, the sprinkling period shall be deemed to be a term of six months, and the rebate or allowance shall be proportionate thereto."

3. Schedule "B" appended to and forming part of said by-Law is hereby amended by striking out the words and figures "use of garden hose and sprinkler (payable in two instalments in second and third quarters)- \$1.50."

This By-Law may be cited for all purposes as the "Waterworks Regulation Amendment By-Law, 1922."
