The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report

THAT the sum voted by the Legislature under Vote 20, as set out in the Estimates for the fiscal year 1922-23, is insufficient to meet necessary expenditures up to and including the 31st March, 1923;

THAT the additional sums provided by Order-in-Council No. 1233, approved October 10th, 1922, and by the Supplementary Estimates of Expenditure (Vote 20) for the fiscal year ending 31st March, 1923 have also been found insufficient:

THAT the expenditure is urgently and immediately required for the public good, and that the Minister of Finance reports that there is no legislative authority for the proposed expenditure:

AND TO RECOMMEND that a special warrant do issue in the sum set out hereunder opposite the above mentioned Vote, such sum having been estimated as being urgently and immediately required for the purposes set out under said Vote for the public good:

Vote 20 - Tubercular Cattle, - Compensation, supplies, temporary assistance, etc. \$12,500.00
