The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

That the B. C. Brush Works Ltd. of Vancouver, paid personal property taxes for the years 1920 and 1921 under protest. The taxes for these years were levied on personal property assessments respectively of \$9336.00 and \$10691.00. The Company claimed certain parts of their plant and fixtures were not assessable as personal property, which claim on the report of the Departmental Auditor, has now been allowed, and which has reduced their assessments respectively to \$8553.00 and \$9878.00.

AND TO RECOMMEND under the provisions of Section 2 of the "Revenue Act Amendment Act, 1920",

That the said B. C. Brush Works Ltd. be refunded the sum of \$15.95, being the difference in taxes between the original and amended assessments.
