The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report, pursuant to Section 120 A of the "Placer Mining Act", being Chapter 59 of the Statutes of 1920, that an application has been received from the Del Ecuador Mines Company, Limited Liability, for permission to consolidate Placer Mining Leases Nos. 1792, 1793, 1794 and 1803, in the Quesnel Mining Division;

That the case is not provided for in Sections 117 or 118 of the said Act;

That the Gold Commissioner of the Mining Division, Mr. H. B. Campbell, recommends that the same be granted;

And to recommend that the said Gold Commissioner be authorized to consolidate said leases upon the condition that the Lessees perform in each and every year on one or more of the grounds comprised in such leases, all the work that is necessary to be performed to hold all such leases or to pay and record the payment in lieu of work required in respect thereof.
