The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report

THAT the Superintendent of the Provincial Industrial School for Boys reports that on the 6th day of December, 1922, Douglas Lukey was committed by Henry C. Shaw, Police Magistrate and Judge of the Juvenile Court for the City of Vancouver, to the Provincial Industrial School for Boys;

THAT from the evidence submitted it appears the said Douglas Lukey is incorrigible, having been apprehended, during the last two and a half years on five distinct charges, three being deliberate burglary and two automobile stealing, as well as having committed other offences.

THAT the Superintendent of the Provincial Industrial School for Boys further reports that there are no facilities at the School for handling Douglas Lukey and that he is a menace to the other inmates.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT, under the provisions of section 6. of Chap. 106, R.S.B.C. 1911, the said Douglas Lukey be forthwith removed from the custody of the Superintendent of the Provincial Industrial School for Boys to Oakalla Prison Farm.

AND THAT a certified copy of this Minute, if approved, be sent to the Superintendent of the Provincial Industrial School for Boys, and to the Warden of Oakalla Prison Farm.
