The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT under the provisions of the Taxation Act and the Income and Personal Property Taxation Act, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorised from time to time to appoint one or more person or persons in any assessment district to be a Court of Revision with power to establish more than one Court of Revision for the same assessment district:

THAT in order to promote and facilitate the collection and recovery of taxes and to give full and due effect to the meaning and intent of the said Acts, it is necessary and desirable that another person be appointed to be a Court of Revision and Appeal for the Slocan Assessment District in respect of taxation of mines assessed under the said Act to act in addition to F.T.ABEY, Judge of the Court of Revision and Appeal for the said District:

AND TO RECOMMEND:-

THAT JAMES O'SHEA, Barrister of Nelson, British Columbia, be appointed to be an additional Court of Revision and Appeal to act on all complaints and appeals tried or heard during the year 1923 in respect only of the assessment for the Slocan Assessment District of the income and output from mines assessed under the provisions of the said Acts:

THAT in all other respects the said F.T.ABEY as a Court of Revision for the Slocan Assessment District in respect of matters other than those referred to herein be confirmed.
