The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report that:—

WHEREAS the Official Guardian for the District of Vancouver received the sum of \$1,000.00 for distribution amongst the infant children of Mrs. Amelia Ball of 111 Irwin Street, Nanaimo, B. C., which was payable to the said Mrs. Ball for the purpose of maintenance of the said infant children by monthly instalments;

AND WHEREAS the said Official Guardian has deducted Fifty Dollars, being 5% of the gross value of the estate, and which was payable to the Minister of Finance by way of commission for acting in the matter;

AND WHEREAS it has been represented to the Government that such deduction will create a great hardship and prevent the said infant children from obtaining the necessaries of life to the extent of the same;

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED THAT, under and by virtue of Section 55 of the Revenue Act, the said sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) be refunded to the said Amelia Ball.
