The undersigned has the honour to report

THAT the sum of \$7,095.00 was received by the Corporation of the District of Oak Bay under the provisions of Section 108 of the "Government Liquor Act" prior to the coming into force of the "Government Liquor Act Amendment Act, 1922";

AND THAT of this amount the sum of \$3,547.50 is required in accordance with the said Act to be used for maintaining or granting aid to Hospitals in the Municipality;
