WHEREAS Bruce Alfred BLACKMAN was charged with six(6) counts of first degree murder and by order of Judge K. J. Husband of the Provincial Court at Port Coquitlam, B.C., on February 9, 1983, was on account of insanity, found unfit to stand his trial and was ordered to be held in custody at the Forensic Psychiatric Institute until the pleasure of the Lieutenant Governor is known;

Bruce Alfred BLACKMAN be held in safe custody in the Forensic Psychiatric Institute and when he has sufficiently recovered from his mental illness be taken to a Court of competent jurisdiction for trial or other disposition according to law.
