## RAILWAY ACT

Chapter 329 R.S.B.C. 1960

Application having been made by the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority Railway for leave to revise the existing automatic signal protection at Scott Rd., Mile 4.57, Fraser Valley Branch, Surrey, British Columbia, as shown on Drawing No. 414-D09-C39 filed in the Department of Transport and Communications in support of this application, and the Chief Inspecting Engineer of the Department of Transport and Communications having signified his consent:


NOW THEREFORE, I, JACK DAVIS, Minister of Transport and Communications of the Province of British Columbia, hereby certify that pursuant to the provisions of Section 160 (Sub-sections 1 and 3), I have approved the application of the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Standard flashing light type automatic signals are to be installed along with flashing light signals mounted on a standard A.A.R. Cantilever mast assembly over the roadway, at each side of the railway
- 2) That all costs of installation of the above signals shall be shared as follows:
 

Department of Highways	62½%
B.C. Hydro & Power Authority	37½%
- 3) That all costs of maintenance of the above signals shall be shared as follows:
 

Dept. of Highways	50%
B. C. Hydro & Power Authority	50%
