EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 5. FEB. 1976

Pursuant to the ESCHEATS Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS:

1. The National Health Association, a body incorporated under the Societies Act, was struck from the Register of Societies by the Registrar of Companies and dissolved on the 18th day of June, 1953.
2. At the date of such striking off and dissolution the Company was the registered owner of certain lands and premises situated at the City of Vancouver and more particularly known and described as Lot 17, Block 4, Section 31, Town of Hastings Suburban Lands, Plan 1528 (hereinafter referred to as "the lands"). On June 9, 1946 the Association sold the said lands under an Agreement for Sale to one Elliott Jacob Baron, who subsequently on November 18, 1946 assigned all his interest therein to Douglas William Hargreaves and Ellen Agnes Hargreaves.
3. AND WHEREAS on the 29th day of July, 1948 Douglas William Hargreaves and Ellen Agnes Hargreaves assigned all their interest under the Agreement for Sale and the said lands to Alexander Thompson and Belle Thompson, joint tenants, and the said Belle Thompson died on May 29th, 1968 and all her interest in the said lands and the said Agreement for Sale passed by transmission to Alexander Thompson.
4. AND WHEREAS after taking assignment of the said Agreement for Sale Alexander Thompson and Belle Thompson made monthly payments due under the said Agreement in the sum of \$36.85 to the National Health Association, but whereas after December, 1948 they found the office of the Association closed, with no direction as to forwarding address, they received no further advice from the Association or any liquidator thereof as to the payment of monthly payments, they made no such further payments after December, 1948.
5. AND WHEREAS at that time the sum of \$2,361.42 with interest at 6%, or a per diem rate of .388 cents per day, was due and owing on the said Agreement and the total amount of capital interest due on the Agreement now amounts to \$6,215.42 as of January 16, 1975 and trust cheque from Mr. Thompson's lawyer payable to the Minister of Finance in this sum has been received.
6. Alexander Thompson has asserted a legal and moral claim to the lands and has applied for a grant to him of the said lands;

All the right, title and interest of the Crown in the Right of the Province of British Columbia acquired by the escheat of the lands but not further or otherwise be granted and conveyed to Alexander Thompson without further formal instrument of transfer.
