EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA -5.FEB.1976

Pursuant to the Lieutenant-Governor Park Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Administrator~~ and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Order-in-Council 398[✓], approved April 4, 1940, established Elk River Class "C" Provincial Park over the following described lands:

Lots A and B of Block 1,
Lot 5455, Kootenay District,
Registered Plan 1613,
together with that tract of land consisting of an island, or islands, situated in the Elk River and lying immediately to the east of the south half of Lot 5455, Kootenay District, and excepting thereout the right-of-way of the C.N.S. Railway.

AND WHEREAS it is considered to be in the public interest to transfer the administration and control of Elk River Park to the Corporation of the City of Fernie;

Elk River Park be cancelled.
