EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 5. FEB. 1976

Pursuant to the Public Service Superannuation Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

TWO YEARS THREE MONTHS OF the period April 13, 1944 to August 1, 1946 during which John Garfield Allen, Food Service Officer, Alouette River Unit, Department of the Attorney-General, served as a member of Her Majesty's Forces be recognized as pensionable service under the provisions of the said Act;

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT John Garfield Allen be required to make a contribution to the Public Service Superannuation Fund in the amount of \$2,836.08 to cover the aforementioned period, pursuant to Section 2, item "pensionable service", clause (b) of the said Act.
