




CRIMINAL CODE (SECTION 802.1 – STUDENTS) ORDER

Definitions

1 In this order:

“**articled student**” has the same meaning as in the *Legal Profession Act*;

“**law student**” means a person enrolled in

- (a) the Faculty of Law at Thompson Rivers University,
- (b) the Faculty of Law at the University of Victoria, or
- (c) the Peter A. Allard School of Law;

“**practising lawyer**” has the same meaning as in the *Legal Profession Act*;

“**temporary articled student**” means a person enrolled in temporary articles under the rules made under the *Legal Profession Act*.

Articled students, temporary articled students and law students

2 A person is authorized to act as an agent for the purposes of section 802.1 (c) of the *Criminal Code* (Canada) if the person is

- (a) an articled student,
- (b) a temporary articled student, or
- (c) a law student who is doing so, under the supervision of a practising lawyer, as a participant in
 - (i) any of the following associated with the Peter A. Allard School of Law:
 - (A) the Criminal Clinic;
 - (B) the Indigenous Community Legal Clinic;
 - (C) the Innocence Project;
 - (D) the Law Students’ Legal Advice Program;
 - (E) the Rise Women’s Legal Centre,
 - (ii) the Thompson Rivers University Community Legal Clinic, or
 - (iii) The Law Centre associated with the University of Victoria.
