EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA -9. FEB 1976

Pursuant to the Teachers' Pensions Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Irene Mildred Chapman, teacher, resigned from the teaching service June 30, 1954 and received a refund of her contributions to the Teachers' Pensions Fund in the amount of \$548.00;

AND WHEREAS Irene Mildred Chapman has requested in writing that this account be reinstated;

AND WHEREAS Irene Mildred Chapman is now a contributor to the Teachers' Pensions Fund having commenced contributions once again on February 1, 1960;

THE PERIOD September 1, 1947 to June 30, 1954, be recognized as pensionable service under the provisions of the said Act.

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT Irene Mildred Chapman be required to make a contribution to the Teachers' Pensions Fund in the amount of \$1,818.27 to cover the aforementioned period, pursuant to Section 10, subsection (1a), clause (b) of the said Act.
