Pursuant to the Teachers' Pensions Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Florence Ingeborg Melia, teacher, resigned from the teaching service June 30, 1945 and received a refund of her contributions to the Teachers' Pensions Fund in the amount of \$185.46;

AND WHEREAS Florence Ingeborg Melia has requested in writing that this account be reinstated;

AND WHEREAS Florence Ingeborg Melia is now a contributor to the Teachers' Pensions Fund having commenced contributions once again on January 1, 1958;

THE PERIOD September 1, 1939 to June 30, 1945, be recognized as pensionable service under the provisions of the said Act.

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT Florence Ingeborg Melia be required to make a contribution to the Teachers' Pensions Fund in the amount of \$1,097.14 to cover the aforementioned period, pursuant to Section 10, subsection (1a), clause (b) of the said Act.
