AND WHEREAS by supplementary Letters Patent issued on the 15th day of March 1972, the Regional District of Nanaimo was empowered to undertake the function of trunk sewers and sewage disposal facilities within the regional district:

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board has requested that the regional district be empowered to provide that the Regional Board may, with the consent of the Council of a member municipality, establish and define by by-law the boundaries of a trunk sewer benefitting area which lies within such municipality:

AND WHEREAS the provisions of section 766 of the Municipal Act have been duly complied with:

NOW KNOW YE THAT by these presents We do order and proclaim that on, from and after the date hereof, the following be added to the objects, powers, obligations, duties, limitations and conditions of the Regional District of Nanaimo:

1. "Division X - Sewage Disposal" of supplementary Letters Patent issued on the 15th day of March, 1972, be amended by adding the following paragraph:

"23 The Regional Board may, with the consent of the Council of a member municipality establish and define by by-law the boundaries of a trunk sewer benefitting area which lies within such municipality"

AND THAT the Letters Patent as amended of the Regional District of Nanaimo be deemed to be further amended so as to conform to the premises as and from the date of these supplementary Letters Patent:
