O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Regulations under the Motor Carrier Act made by Order of the Public Utilities Commission on the 4th day of January, 1940, which Regulations were approved by Order-in-Council No. 8 dated the 6th day of January, 1940, and published as B.C. Regulation 59/59 as amended, be further amended as follows:

By deleting paragraph (j) of the said Regulation 1.1 and substituting therefor the following new paragraph (j):-

- (j) (i) Any vehicle while operated pursuant to a permit issued under the provisions of Sec. 11 of the Commercial Transport Act; provided that the person or corporation in whose name the vehicle is registered or licenced outside the Province of British Columbia or to whom it is leased outside the Province, has not obtained, with respect to any vehicle more than six (6) permits under the provisions of Section 11 of the Commercial Transport Act during the current licence year.
- (ii) The exemption from the provisions of the Motor Carrier Act and the Regulations thereunder created by sub-paragraph (j) (i) shall not apply to any person or corporation after six (6) permits have been issued to that person, firm, or corporation under the provisions of Section 11 of the Commercial Transport Act with respect to the operation of any vehicle in any current licence year.
- (iii) Upon it being shown to the satisfaction of the Motor Carrier Commission that a person or corporation has received more than six (6) permits issued pursuant to Section 11 of the Commercial Transport Act in any licence year with respect to the operation of any vehicle or number of vehicles, the Commission may by order

provide that the exemption from the Motor Carrier Act and the Regulations thereunder created by sub-paragraph (j) hereof shall not apply to any vehicle registered or licensed outside the Province of British Columbia in the name of that person or corporation, or leased outside the Province to such person or corporation until by further order of the Commission such exemption is again made applicable to such person or corporation.
