BY-LAW NO. 199

A By-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 54 applicable to Electoral Area "D" only, by the designation of a Development Area.

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COWICHAN VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. By-Law No. 54 of the Cowichan Valley Regional District being zoning By-law applicable to Electoral Area "D" only is hereby amended by designating the area of land situated in the Cowichan Valley Regional District Electoral Area "D" and more particularly known and described as: Lot 1, Section 8, Range 2, Plan 12543, Cowichan District, a Development Area pursuant to Section 702A of the "Municipal Act".
2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as the "Regional District Development Area By-law No. 199, 1975".
