EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 16. FEB. 1976

Pursuant to the Municipal Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS the Council of the District of Coquitlam has by By-law No. 236 cited as "District of Coquitlam Road Closing By-law No. 236, 1973", a copy of which is attached hereto, stopped up and closed to traffic those portions of highway as shown outlined in red colour on the plan attached to and made part of said By-law No. 236; and more particularly described as follows:

"Parcel 'C' (By-law Plan 48966) of Block 2 of District Lot 46, Group 1, New Westminster District."

AND WHEREAS the Council has requested the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the aforesaid portion of highway pursuant to Section 508 and to vest title to the lands comprising same in the name of the municipality and has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Minister of Municipal Affairs that special circumstances exist which warrant the making of this Order:

AND WHEREAS the consent of owners of contiguous properties has been obtained and the question of access is not in issue:

THE REQUEST BE GRANTED and that the portions of highway aforesaid be abandoned and title to the lands comprising same be vested in fee simple in the name of the District of Coquitlam without further instrument of transfer, subject nevertheless to the reservations, limitations, provisos, and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown and subject to the provisions of Section 47 of the Land Act, and also subject to consolidation with the adjoining property.

BY-LAW NO. 236, 1973

A By-law of the District of Coquitlam  
to close a portion of road in District  
Lot 46.

The Council of the District of Coquitlam in open meeting assembled  
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a portion of lane in Block Two (2), District Lot Forty-Six  
(46), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 2624, in the Municipality  
of Coquitlam, in the Province of British Columbia, being described as:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain part, parcel or tract of land  
and premises situate, lying and being a portion of Lane in  
Block Two (2), District Lot Forty-six (46), Group One (1),  
New Westminster District, according to Plan 2624 deposited,  
and being more particularly known and described as all that  
portion of Lane aforesaid, having an area of 0.09 of an acre,  
as shown outlined in red colour on a By-law Plan prepared by  
Ronald G. Scobbie, B.C.L.S. and dated the 25th day of April,  
1973, a copy of which plan is hereunto annexed,

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic of all kinds;

2. This By-law shall be advertised prior to the passing thereof in the  
Coquitlam Columbian;

3. A plan of the said portion of land is attached hereto as a part of  
this By-law;

4. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as the "District of  
Coquitlam Road Closing By-law No. 236, 1973".

READ A SECOND TIME this 1st day of October A.D., 1973.  
READ A THIRD TIME this 1st day of October A.D., 1973.
