EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 16.FEB.1976

Pursuant to the Park Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

Topley Park, which was established as a Class A Provincial Park by Order-In-Council No. 1034, approved April 17, 1964, and amended by Order-In-Council 1108, approved April 9, 1968, be increased by the addition of 15 acres of adjacent Crown Lands and foreshore; said area described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the north boundary of Topley Park, said point being 3.5 chains due east of the northwest corner of Topley Park; thence due north 7.0 chains; thence due east 10.0 chains; thence due south 10 chains more or less to a point, said point being 1 chain from and perpendicular to the natural boundary of Babine Lake; thence generally southerly along a line parallel and perpendicular to the said natural boundary of Babine Lake to a point, said point being the point of intersection of the aforesaid line and the north easterly prolongation of the southeast boundary of Topley Park; thence southwesterly 1 chain along said prolongation to the most easterly corner of Topley Park; thence northwesterly along the northeasterly boundary of Topley Park to the northerly boundary thereof; thence due west along said boundary to the point of commencement and containing 15 acres more or less."

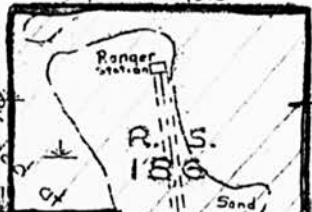
