Application having been made by Wainoco Oil Ltd., Calgary, Alberta, for leave to construct a pipeline from Lsd 11-12-84-19 W6M to 6-24-84-19 W6M, Peace River District, for the purpose of transporting produced water for disposal in the Fort St. John Area, British Columbia, as shown on Drawing No. F-231-75, filed in the Department of Transport and Communications in support of this application, and the Chief Inspecting Engineer of the Department of Transport and Communications having signified his consent:
