The employees enumerated in this Order-in-Council have been in the employ of the Government for some years, but prior to April 1st, 1932, they have been receiving salaries voted by the Legislature for the positions which they were then filling. Since April 1st, 1932, they have been paid from certain votes under the appropriations covering Civil Service salaries, and to legalize their contributing to the Superannuation Fund, it is necessary to approve an Order-in-Council under Section 32D of the Superannuation Act.
