 EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 19 FEB 1976

Pursuant to the Motor-Vehicle Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that :


1. That Division 7 of the Motor-Vehicle Act Regulations be amended by adding as Regulation 7.162 the following:


7.162 A winter tire as defined in Section 198 of the Act shall have not less than four thirty seconds of an inch of tread depth across the surface of the tire in contact with the road.
2. That Division 19 of the Motor-Vehicle Act Regulations is amended by deleting Sub-section 5 of Regulation 19.03 and substituting the following as Sub-section 5 of Regulation 19.03.

(5) No person shall drive or operate on a highway a vehicle unless it is so constructed or loaded as to prevent any of its load,

 - (a) from shifting or swaying in such a manner as to affect the operation of the vehicle, or
 - (b) from dropping, sifting, leaking, or otherwise escaping therefrom, but sand may be dropped for the purpose of securing traction, and water or other substance may be sprinkled on a roadway in cleaning or maintaining the roadway.
