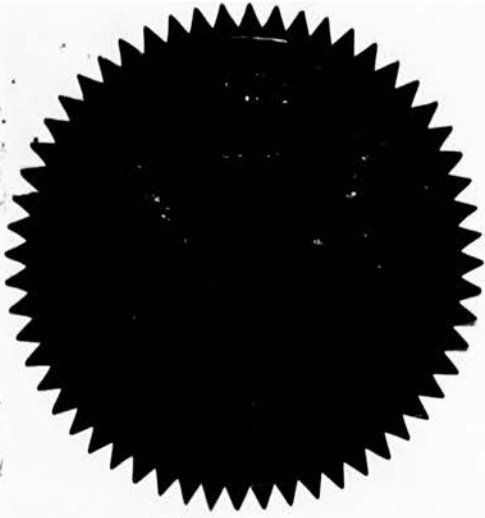

on the recommendation of the Minister, provide in the Letters Patent or supplementary Letters Patent such further objects, powers, obligations, duties, limitations and conditions in respect to any or all functions requested pursuant to the said section:

AND WHEREAS by supplementary Letters Patent dated the 29th day of November, 1973, there was granted to the Regional District the function of providing for the construction, operation, and maintenance of an indoor swimming pool for The Corporation of the City of Nelson and Electoral Area F and defined portion of Electoral Area E:

AND WHEREAS by supplementary Letters Patent dated the 25th day of October, 1974 there was granted to the Regional District the function of the construction, operation, and maintenance of a community centre and ice arena for the City of Castlegar and Electoral Areas I and J:

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay has requested that the Letters Patent be amended to provide for the establishment of one Recreation Commission for each function to administer the aforesaid facilities:

AND WHEREAS the provisions of section

766 of the Municipal Act have been met:

NOW KNOW YE THAT by these presents, We do order and proclaim that on, from, and after the date hereof:-

1. The function of Indoor Swimming Pool granted by supplementary Letters Patent dated the 29th day of November, 1973, be amended by adding the following as paragraph 5:

"5. The Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay may, by by-law, establish a Recreation Commission consisting of the Directors representing the participating member municipalities plus such other persons as may be designated in the by-law and in such by-law may delegate to the Commission any or all of the administrative powers, with the exception of employment of staff with respect to the construction, equipping, operation and maintenance of the functions provided, however, that the costs incurred are within the annual budget as approved by the Regional District", and

2. The function of Community Centre and Ice Arena granted by supplementary Letters Patent dated the 25th day of October, 1974, be amended by adding the following as paragraph 5:

"5. The Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay may, by by-law, establish a Recreation Commission consisting of the Directors representing the participating member municipalities plus such other persons as may be designated in the by-law and in such

by-law may delegate to the Commission any or all of the administrative powers, with the exception of employment of staff with respect to the construction, equipping, operation and maintenance of the functions provided, however, that the costs incurred are within the annual budget as approved by the Regional District."

AND THAT the Letters Patent as amended of the Regional District of Central Kootenay be deemed to be further amended accordingly.
