Pursuant to the Park Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

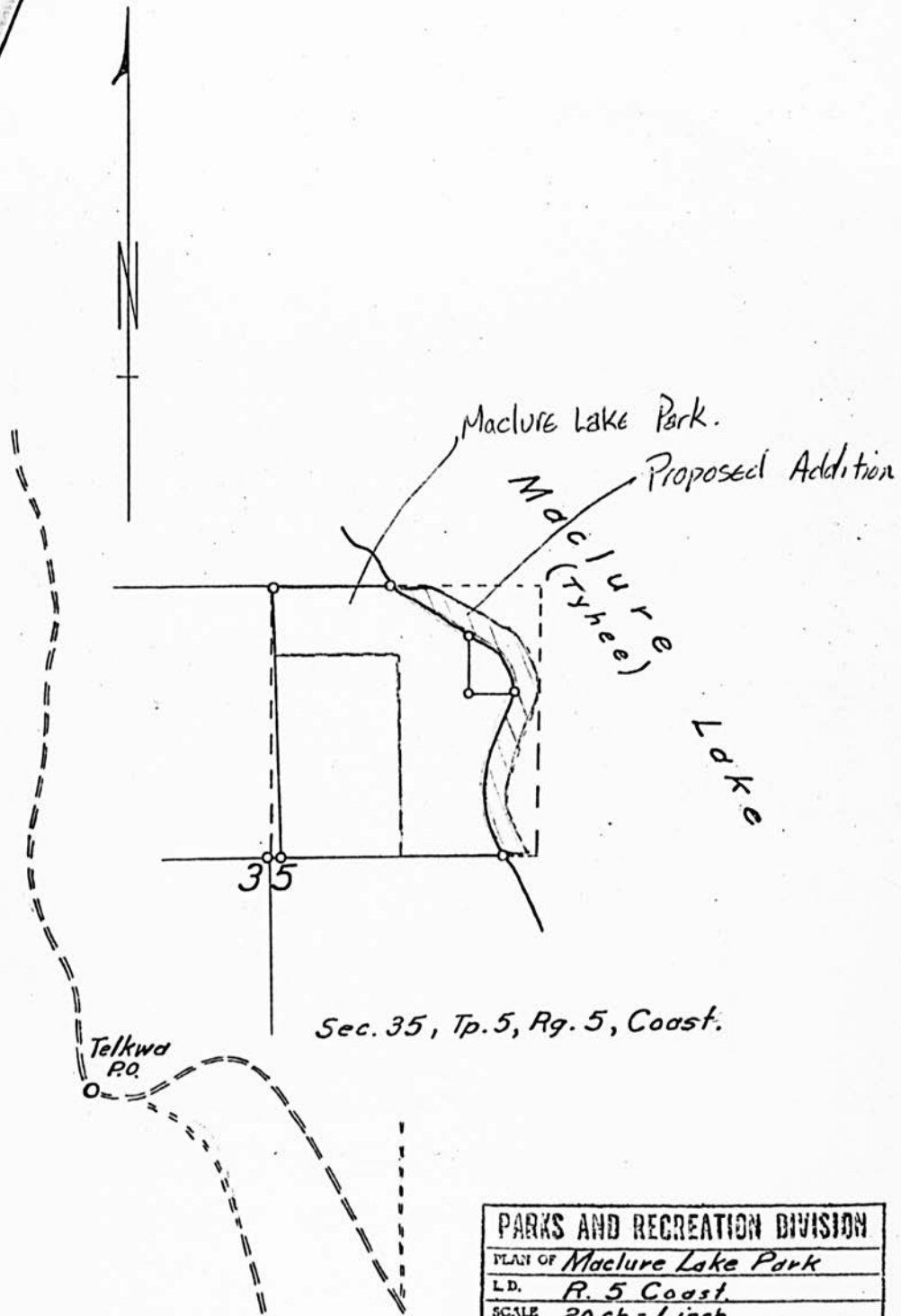
Maclure Lake Park, which was established as a Class A Provincial Park by Order-In-Council No. 795 approved April 11, 1956, be increased by the addition of 21 acres of adjacent Crown foreshore, said foreshore described as follows:

"Commencing at the southeasterly corner of the Fractional N.E. ¼ of Section 35, Township 5, Range 5, Coast District being a point on the natural boundary of the westerly shore of Maclure Lake; thence due east a distance of 200 feet; thence northerly along a line parallel and perpendicular to the said natural boundary of Maclure Lake Park to a point due east of the northeast corner of the Fractional N.E. ¼ of Section 35, Township 5, Range 5, Coast District; thence due west to the said northeast corner; thence southerly along the said natural boundary of the westerly shore of Maclure Lake to the point of commencement and containing 21 acres more or less."
